


LIFE Groups


God has a better plan for you—a plan for you to live in victory. That’s why he has silenced your giant once and for all.



Not a Fan

Jesus never asked us to sit on the sidelines and cheer for his cause.” — Craig Groeschel, senior pastor of LifeChurch.tv
